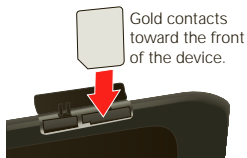
ASSEMBLE & CHARGE

Caution: Before assembling, charging, or using your device for the first time, please read the important legal and safety information packaged with your product.

- 1** Open the Micro SIM cover at the bottom of the device.



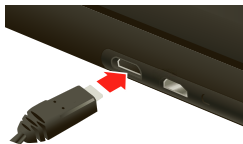
- 2** Insert the Micro SIM.



- 3** Close the Micro SIM cover.



- 4** Charge up.




Caution: Power off the tablet before removing the Micro SIM.

The charging light turns white during charging, then turns off when fully charged.

Note: The battery should only be replaced by a Motorola-approved service facility. Any attempt to remove or replace your battery may damage the product and void the warranty.

START UP

- 1 Press and hold Power/Lock  on the back of your tablet to turn it on.
- 2 If desired, change the language setting, then touch **Start**.
When you touch **Start**, your tablet attempts to activate your mobile service (if not already activated).
- 3 If you go on to Wi-Fi setup, you see a **Wi-Fi setup** screen. Connect to an existing network, add a new network, or skip Wi-Fi setup for now and set up later (see “Wi-Fi” on page 15).
- 4 Choose location settings and touch **Next** (for the most accurate location features, check both services).
- 5 Follow the setup wizard to create or log into your Google™ Account and go to the home screen.

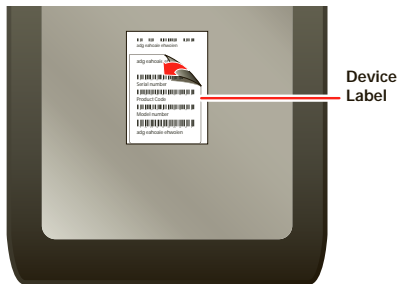

BASICS

TOUCH

It's all in the touch:

- Touch: Choose an icon or option.
- Touch & Hold: Open options.
- Drag: Scroll or move slowly.
- Flick: Scroll or move quickly.
- Pinch-to-zoom: Get a closer look at Google Maps™, web pages, and photos.

Flick or drag to scroll.



Touch to open.

Touch & hold to move.







Tip: When using a mouse with the device, you can also double-click to zoom.




HOME SCREEN



Your home screen is your personally designed launch pad. You'll see the home screen when you turn on the tablet or touch Home  from a menu.

Note: This home screen display is simulated. Actual displays may vary.


-   Search: Search with text or voice.
-  App menu: See all your apps (if you have a lot, flick left and right to see them all).
-  Back: Go back one screen.
-  Home: Return to the home screen at any point.
-  Recent apps: Show thumbnails of your recent apps (touch a thumbnail to open the app).

- **Panels:** Flick left or right to show the five home screen panels. Use panels to organize your widgets and shortcuts. To return to the center panel, touch Home .
- **Notifications:** Touch the clock in the bottom right to show your tablet's status and details about any new messages or other notifications.
- **Menu:** When you see  in the top right, or  in the bottom left, you can touch them to open a menu for the screen you're on.

USE & CHANGE YOUR HOME SCREEN

On your home screen, shortcuts are icons that open your favorite apps, Web bookmarks, music playlists, and more. Widgets show you the date, updates, and more. The Calendar widget is an example of a scrollable widget—you can scroll through your calendar within the widget itself, on the home page, without opening the calendar app. The Books widget is an example of a stacked widget—you can flick through your content within the widget itself, on the home screen, without opening the Books app.



Flick left and right to see more home screen panels of shortcuts and widgets.

- **Customize:** To add widgets, app shortcuts, wallpapers, and more to your home screen, touch  at the top of the screen.
- **Resize widget:** Touch and hold the widget, then let go. Once the highlighted frame appears drag one of the pointers to resize the frame.

NOTIFICATIONS



The notification panel at the bottom of the home screen contains icons that tell you about new messages, available app downloads, network signal strength, and other tablet status indicators. Touch an individual icon to see that email, meeting reminder, or other notification. Or, touch the digital time display to open the entire notification panel to see all new message notifications, status icons, and other useful data.



SEARCH

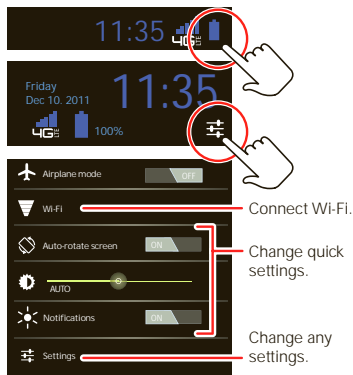
The search window on your home screen gives you two search options. For a text search, touch the search window, enter your keyword(s), then touch . To search by voice, touch  and speak your keyword(s) when prompted.

SETTINGS


Open the Quick Settings menu to change settings for brightness, sound, screen orientation, airplane mode, network, and notifications.

- 1 Touch the clock at the bottom of the home screen.
- 2 Touch .
- 3 Change a quick setting, or touch  **Settings** to see all tablet settings.

Tip: You can also go to tablet settings by touching  **Apps** >  **Settings**.





APP MENU

Touch  **Apps** from the home screen to see your tablet's apps.

To close the app tray, touch Home  or Back .


KEY TIPS

LOCK/UNLOCK

Lock the touchscreen by pressing Power/Lock . To unlock the touchscreen, just press the Power/Lock  again, then drag  out of the circle.

CHANGE VOLUME

Press the volume keys to adjust the volume.

Droid Xyboard 10.1 by Motorola gives you many ways to connect with your world.

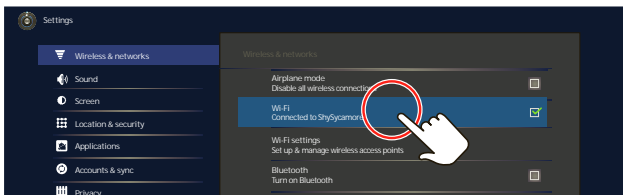
4G LTE CONNECTION

Your device uses the 4G LTE mobile network wherever it's available. You'll know you're connected when you see **4G** on the screen.

WI-FI

It's easy to connect to a Wi-Fi network. Newly added proxy support makes sure you stay connected.

- 1 Touch the clock at the bottom of the screen.
- 2 Touch **Settings**.
- 3 Touch **Wi-Fi**.
- 4 In **Wireless & networks**, select **Wi-Fi**.



Your tablet scans for and shows all available Wi-Fi networks.

Note: Your device's Wi-Fi features and power levels are not allowed for outdoor operation in France. To avoid unlawful interference with radio signals, do not use the Wi-Fi features in France unless you are indoors.

USB CONNECTION

Transfer HD video, music, pictures, photos and other media content between your tablet and a computer—a USB connection makes it easy. Use the USB cable that came with your tablet to make the connection, then:

- Microsoft™ Windows™ XP, Windows Vista, and Windows 7—On your computer, press Start, open your list of programs, and select Windows Explorer. Then drag and drop files from your computer to your tablet.
- Apple™ Macintosh™—Use Android File Transfer. (You can download it from android.com/filetransfer. Requires Mac OS x 10.5 or later.)

HDMI

You can snap photos and capture videos, then sit back and enjoy them on your HDTV at home. Your tablet's HDMI port lets you connect it to other HDMI devices.

BLUETOOTH® WIRELESS

With Bluetooth wireless technology, you can enjoy your music on a Bluetooth-enabled stereo headset, or connect to a Bluetooth keypad and mouse for quick and easy text entry. With newly added Bluetooth support for Google Talk, you can chat hands-free using a Bluetooth headset or car kit.

CONTENT BACKUP

BACKUP ASSISTANTSM

Backup Assistant is a free service from Verizon Wireless which saves your device's address book to a secure server. If your device is lost or damaged, or if you upgrade to a new device, Backup Assistant will restore your contacts.

V CAST™ MEDIA MANAGER

Transfer pictures, videos and music between your device and computer with just a USB cable connection. Includes a media player and media management tools. Go to verizonwireless.com/vmm to download your free copy.

GOOGLE™ ACCOUNT

STREAM CONTENT WITH MOTOCAST

MotoCast is an exclusive free app from Motorola that lets you stream content between your PC and tablet any time you have a network connection—music, videos, photos, and documents.

To get started, touch  >  **MotoCast** and follow the on-screen instructions to create an account on your tablet. You'll be prompted to download and install MotoCast on your computer. Log into the same account and specify the files you want to share.

Next, finish the setup process on your tablet to share your files.

FLOATING NOTES


Floating Notes let you write notes freehand and then save them, send them in email, or move them to  **Tasks**. Touch  in the status bar, then select an option.



- Small: Open a small notepad for note-taking.
- Large: Open a large notepad.


- **Open:** Retrieve and open an existing note.
- **Evernote:** Open the Evernote app.

From an open notepad, you can select one of these options:



- **File:** Select **New**; **Save As**; **Delete**; **Taskify** (to be used in  **Tasks**); **Share** via Bluetooth®, Gmail, and more; or **Settings**.
- **Save:** Save the current note.
- **Brush:** Select a color for recording the note.
- **Eraser:** Erase note entries (if the note has not been saved).
- **Text:** Enter note text with a keyboard.
- **Undo:** Undo the last change.
- **Redo:** Reverse an **Undo**.
- **List:** Display a list of saved notes.

TROUBLESHOOTING

FORCED REBOOT

In the unlikely event that your device becomes unresponsive, try a forced reboot: Press and hold both Power/Lock  and the down volume key for more than 12 seconds.

RESET

To reset your tablet to factory settings and erase all the data on your device, from the home screen, touch  **Apps** >  **Settings** > **Privacy** > **Factory data reset**.

Warning: All data on your tablet will be deleted.

TOTAL EQUIPMENT COVERAGE
