

FIRST STEPS

GETTING STARTED

ASSEMBLE & CHARGE

Caution: Before assembling, charging, or using your device for the first time, please read the important safety, regulatory, and legal information provided with your product.



Caution: Power off the tablet before removing the SIM card. If you remove a card while the tablet is powered on, you may lose data.

When you plug in a charger, your tablet turns on. If you have a low battery, the Charging Light shows until your tablet can turn on. When your tablet is on, touch the battery icon in the bottom right of the display for detailed charging status.

Note: The battery should only be replaced by a Motorola-approved service facility. Any attempt to remove or replace your battery may damage the product and void your warranty.

STARTUP

- 1 Press and hold Power/Lock 🗃 🛈 on the back of your tablet to turn it on.
- 2 If desired, change the language setting, then touch Start. When you touch Start, your tablet attempts to activate your mobile service (if not already activated).
- 3 If you go on to Wi-Fi setup, you see a **Wi-Fi setup** screen. Connect to an existing network, add a new network, or skip Wi-Fi setup for now and set up later (see "Wi-Fi" on page 15).
- 4 Choose location settings and touch Next (for the most accurate location features, check both services).
- 5 Follow the setup wizard to create or log into your Google™ Account and go to the home screen.



TOUCH

It's all in the touch:

- Touch: Choose an icon or option.
- Touch & Hold: Move, or open options.
- Drag: Scroll or move slowly.
- Flick: Scroll or move quickly.
- Pinch-to-zoom: Get a closer look at Google Maps™, web pages, or photos.

Tip: When using a mouse with the device, you can also double-click to zoom.



Touch & hold to move items on the home screen, or to open options for items in lists.

Flick or drag to scroll.

Touch to open.

Your home screen is your personally designed launch pad. You'll see the home screen when you turn on the tablet or touch Home from a menu.

Note: This home screen display is simulated. Actual displays may vary.

- Search: Q Search with text or voice.
- App menu: See all your apps (if you have a lot, flick left and right to see them all).
- Back: Go back one screen
- Home: Return to the home screen at any point.
- Recent apps: Show thumbnails of your recent apps (touch a thumbnail to open the app).
- Notifications: Touch the clock in the bottom right to show your tablet's status and details about any new messages or other notifications.
- Menu: When you see I in the top right, or in the bottom left, you can touch them to open a menu for the screen you're on.



USE & CHANGE YOUR HOME SCREEN

On your home screen. shortcuts are icons that open your favorite apps, Web bookmarks, music playlists, and more. Widgets show you the date, updates, and more. The Calendar widget is an example of a scrollable widget—you can scroll through your calendar within the widget itself, on the home page, without opening the calendar app. The Books widget is an example of a stacked widget—you can flick through your content within the widget itself, on the home screen, without opening the Books app.

Flick left and right to see more home screen panels of shortcuts and widgets.



Add widgets, wallpaper, and more to vour home screen.

Touch & hold, then drag widgets or shortcuts to a new spot or the trash can in the top right.





- Customize: To add widgets, app shortcuts, wallpapers, and more to your home screen, touch → at the top right of the screen.
- Resize a widget: Touch and hold the widget until it vibrates, then let go. A highlighted frame appears around the widget—drag a corner to resize.

NOTIFICATIONS

The notification panel at the bottom right of the home screen contains icons that tell you about new messages, available app downloads, network signal strength, and other tablet

status indicators. Touch an individual icon to see that email, meeting reminder, or other notification. Or, touch the digital time display to open the entire notification panel to see all new message notifications, status icons, and other useful data.

SEARCH

The search window on your home screen gives you two search options. For a text search, touch the search window, enter your keyword(s), then touch . To search by voice, touch and speak your keyword(s) when prompted.

SETTINGS

Open the Quick Settings Menu to change settings for brightness, sound, screen orientation, airplane mode, network, and notifications.

- 1 Touch the clock at the bottom of the home screen.
- 2 Touch 🖪.
- 3 Change a quick setting, or touch **Settings** to see all tablet settings.


Tip: You can also go to tablet settings by touching

Apps > Settings.

APP MENU

Touch **Apps** from the home screen to see your tablet's apps.

To close the app tray, touch Home _ or Back _.



SLEEP & WAKE UP

Put the touchscreen to sleep by pressing Power/Lock (a). To wake up the touchscreen, just press the Power/Lock (a) again, then drag (b) out of the circle.

On the back: Power/Sleep Key Hold=power, Press=sleep Volume Keys

CHANGE VOLUME

Press the volume keys to adjust the volume.

SET UP EMAIL

The first time you turned on your tablet (see page 6), you may have logged in to your Google Account.

You can add other email accounts:

- If you want to set up additional Google Accounts, touch Apps > Settings > Accounts & sync > Add account.
- If you want to set up other email accounts, touch Apps > Email, then follow the step-by-step instructions to set up a POP3, IMAP, or corporate account.

CONNECTIONS

Your tablet gives you many ways to connect with your world.

4G LTE CONNECTION

Your tablet uses the 4G LTE mobile network wherever it's available. You'll know you're connected when you see **4GE** on the screen.

WI-FI

It's easy to connect to a Wi-Fi network. Newly added proxy support makes sure you stay connected.

- 1 Touch the clock at the bottom of the screen.
- 2 Touch **茸**. Settings
- 3 Touch Wi-Fi.
- 4 In Wireless & networks, select Wi-Fi.

Your tablet scans for and shows all available Wi-Fi networks.

USB CONNECTION

You can transfer HD video, music, pictures, photos and other media content between your tablet and a computer. A USB connection makes it easy. Use the USB cable that came with your tablet to make the connection and do the following:

- Microsoft™ Windows™ XP, Windows Vista, and Windows 7—On your computer, press Start, open your list of programs, and select Windows Explorer. Then drag and drop files from your computer to your tablet.
- Apple™ Macintosh™—Use Android File Transfer. (You can download it from android.com/filetransfer. This requires Mac OS x 10.5 or later.)

HDMI

You can snap photos and capture videos, then sit back and enjoy them on your HDTV at home. Your tablet's HDMI port lets you connect it to other HDMI devices.

BLUETOOTH® WIRELESS

With Bluetooth wireless technology, you can enjoy your music on a Bluetooth-enabled stereo headset, or connect to a Bluetooth keypad and mouse for quick and easy text entry. With newly added Bluetooth support for Google Talk, you can chat hands-free using a Bluetooth headset or car kit.

MOTOCAST™

MotoCast is an exclusive free app from Motorola that lets you stream content from your PC to your tablet any time you have a network connection—music, photos, videos and documents!



TROUBLESHOOTING

FORCED REBOOT

In the unlikely event that your device becomes unresponsive, try a forced reboot: Press and hold both Power/Lock ao and the down volume key for more than 12 seconds.

RESET

If you forget your unlock pattern or password, you can do a factory data reset to restore your tablet to its factory settings:

Warning: This deletes all of your data on the tablet. This includes pictures, videos, documents, and other files that you have not backed up online or on a PC.

- 1 Turn off your tablet (if necessary, see "Forced reboot").
- 2 Press and hold both volume keys while you press Power/Lock (a). Your tablet should show the Boot Mode menu.
 - Press the volume down key to scroll to Recovery mode, then press the volume up key to activate it.
- **3** When you see the Android logo, press both volume keys at the same time. Your tablet should show the Recovery screen.
 - a Press the volume down key to scroll to the factory reset option, then press Power/Lock @① to activate it.
 - **b** Press the volume down key to scroll to the Yes confirmation, then press Power/Lock **a** o to activate it.
